**Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> November. Kirstenbosch breakfast and walkabout.**

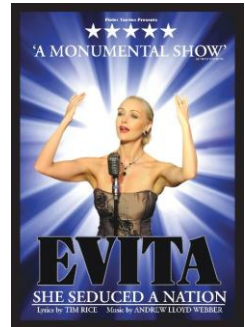
